PURPOSE The Hmong Georgia Community, Inc. Scholarship Fund is newly established, as of 2018. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to Hmong Georgia residents that are currently enrolled in community colleges, colleges and universities.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance and GPA. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Hmong Georgia Community, Inc. awards scholarships based on a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. The organization pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient. Scholarships are awarded annually, typically during the Hmong Georgia New Year celebrations in November. The scholarship awards are awarded without regard to gender or sexual orientation, however, the scholarship is limited to only Hmong college students within the state of Georgia. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a student at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States and a resident of Georgia.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by October 25th, 2018.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due October 25th, 2018 with no exception of a later date.
- Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship Committee conducted in early November.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by November 5th, 2018 via email.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing, including transcript.
- A letter stating the objective in how the funding will assist applicant with current studies/college needs.
 (Please include topics regarding positive movements you would like to participate in to assist the Hmong Georgia community.)

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Awards will be given on Saturday, November 10th, 2018 at the Hmong Georgia New Year Celebration.
- Award amounts will be distributed at the award ceremony, after all requirements are met.
